Request description

From June 1, 2023 through January 1, 2024, I request a sample of up to 10 completed FOIA case files from your office's FOIA tracking system where scope clarification occurred. Each case must have all of: (1) a written agency response seeking clarification about the scope of records sought; (2) a written requester response that clarified the request; (3) a final determination letter; and (4) a case closure date within the specified date range. For each of these case files, I seek only: (1) the initial FOIA request; (2) the agency's scope clarification letter (or email or similar record); (3) the requester's clarification response or the request as it was ultimately processed; (4) and the final determination letter. Specifically, for a sample of requests where clarification was needed, I'm looking for the original request, the rationale for clarification, and the clarified request. I am studying how agencies and requesters work together to clarify and refine requests, so I need only the substance of these communications, not any personally identifying details. To reduce processing time and protect privacy: please exclude any Privacy Act requests, cases where clarification was sought solely about fees, and cases where the requester never responded with clarification. And please redact all personal information (names, addresses, emails, phone numbers). If your office cannot find 10 completed case files with these criteria, please send as many case files as you can find that do.

I meet the statutory definition of a "representative of the news media." I am a senior fellow at the Government Accountability Project (GAP), a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization dedicated to government transparency and accountability, and a freelance journalist with a documented history of disseminating information to the public. As a regular contributor to GAP's news blog and other media outlets, I produce content that reaches a wide audience. The D.C. Circuit has established that news media status focuses on the nature of the requester, not the specific request. The requested records directly reveal specific information about federal FOIA operations, particularly how agencies work with requesters to clarify and refine requests. This provides insight into a core government function — namely, how agencies implement FOIA's mandate for public access to government records. The requested information will advance public knowledge by revealing patterns in how federal agencies communicate with FOIA requesters, identifying best practices and potential areas for improvement in FOIA processing, providing concrete examples of successful request clarification processes, and help future requesters better frame their FOIA requests. This analysis will go beyond currently available information by offering detailed insights into the scope clarification process across federal agencies. I have concrete plans to analyze the records and share my findings with the FOIA requester community and the general public. Through GAP's established platforms—including blogs, newsletters, and media partnerships—I will disseminate the information widely. While case law indicates that proof of dissemination capacity is not required, my track record demonstrates my ability to effectively reach and inform a broad audience. This request is not for commercial use. GAP is a nonprofit organization that will receive no commercial benefit from the disclosed information. The records will be used solely for public education and advocacy purposes, aligning with GAP's mission to promote government accountability and transparency. If a full fee waiver is not granted, I request to be classified as a representative of the news media and charged only for duplication costs after the first 100 pages, as stipulated under FOIA provisions. On October 24, 2023 you submitted a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request regarding the Hario Commissary store manager hiring action.

Specifically, you requested the score cards, original announcement, resumes, and candidate list.
